

You may apply to only 1 program.

Incomplete applications or applications with error shall not be taken into consideration and thus will be rejected.

Minimum graduate admission requirements:

- A bachelor's degree from an accredited institution or recognized equivalent.
- Sufficient undergraduate education for graduate work in your chosen field.

INFORMATION FOR NON-ENVIROMENTAL ENGINEERING MAJORS

Applicants who have earned a Bachelor's degree in a field other than Environmental Engineering are required to take a one-year Scientific Preparation Program. Admissions committee decides on the number of courses to be taken within the program (max. 30 ECTS credits) based on the transcript and GPA of the candidate.
